Referral letter:

A current referral letter is required for your appointment. Referrals from GPs and Optometrists expire every 12 months, and referrals from other specialists expire after 3 months.

On the day of your appointment:

- Any current prescription glasses should be brought to your appointment.
- Prior to seeing Dr Then, you will be assessed by our technician and dilating drops may be inserted in your eyes. This will result in mild blurring of your vision which may last from 1-6 hours depending on the sensitivity of your eyes. We do not recommend that you drive after your appointment, therefore please arrange for someone to drive you home. Please be aware that if you decline to have dilating drops, Dr Then may request that your appointment be re-scheduled if dilation is required for best results.
- Your photo may be taken if you are undergoing an oculoplastic procedure. Any photos are confidential and kept for our records only.
- We will endeavour to see you as close to your appointment time as possible. However, due to emergencies or unforeseen circumstances, your appointment may run late. Our receptionists will advise you of the approximate wait time on your arrival. If Dr Then is running very late, you will be offered the opportunity to re-schedule your appointment.
